The Township of Cramahe is located in the heart of Northumberland County, just over an hour's drive east of Toronto on the north shore of Lake Ontario.

The Municipality is seeking applications to fill the position of Summer Student within our Transportation & Environmental Services Department.

The position reports to the Lead Hand of Transportation & Environmental Services, and is responsible for:

- Assisting with brushing, mowing, ditching of Township roadways
- Patching, sweeping, and minor repairs of roads
- General shop maintenance/cleaning
- Performs minor asphalt repairs
- Flagging duties during construction operations
- Assisting with tree and brush falling, removal and chipping
- Maintenance and minor repair of equipment (oil change, grease, light bulbs, etc.)
- General light duty work including but not limited to painting, garage cleaning, landscaping.
- Other duties as assigned

Success in the position requires the ability to work, understand and interpret Health and Safety policies, written and oral instructions and machinery operating materials. Ability to complete assigned tasks with only occasional supervision, work in a construction setting and in all weather conditions.

The preferred candidate must be aged 16 to 30 years, will possess a full class G driver's license and safety footwear. An acceptable driver's abstract and Criminal Records Check (over age 18) will be required if hired. Proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 will be required.
