The Royal Canadian Legion's Bells of Peace will mark the moment 100 years ago when **CHURCH BELLS** across Canada rang out to share the news that the "**FIRST WORLD WAR**" had ended. At the going down of the sun (4:45pm) on Sunday November 11th, 2018 the bells will ring 100 times in Communities across the country to honour the sacrifices of Canadians who served in the 1914-1918 War, the costs to society and the promise of peace.

Colborne Legion Branch 187 will participate in the **BELLS OF PEACE** at 4 locations in our community.

The Bells will ring 100 times at the following locations:

- The Old United Church
- Presbyterian Church Belfry
- Presbyterian Church - the Church has two Bells and both Bells will be struck. The one in the Belfry first and at the conclusion of the Belfry Bell the Bell in front of the Church will complete it's strikes.
- Bell in front of Branch 187 Colborne Legion
- And the last ringing of the Bells will be at Victoria Square followed by the playing of Amazing Grace by a Piper from 8th Wing Sqaudron in Trenton
