Message from the Chief

Attention residents of Cramahe – today, you may have received a phone call, email, or text message stating that Cramahe Township is currently at a level 4 fire risk. A level 4 fire risk means that conditions are very dry and you must exercise extreme caution when open air burning. A level 4 fire risk does not mean there is a burn ban, but rather this message was sent to ensure people are using extreme caution and care at this time. Please **DO NOT** burn yard waste, such as leaves, twigs, etc. Please be advised that any yard waste can be placed at the curb for free pick-up.

Please be aware that an official burn ban could be implemented at any time and if this happens, an updated message will be posted on social media.

Your adherence to open air burning permit regulations will greatly assist first responders during this difficult time. Thank you for your cooperation.
