

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRAMAHE

BY-LAW NO. BL-2022-42

Being a By-law to Establish a Joint Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee 2022, for The Corporation of The Township of Cramahé and Northumberland County Partner Municipalities.

Whereas sub-section 88.37(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, requires the Council to establish a Compliance Audit Committee, before October 1, 2022, for the purposes of Section 88.33 to Section 88.37 of the Act; and

Whereas Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cramahé on May 17, 2022, passed By-law 2022-30 to establish a Joint Municipal Election Audit Committee; and


Whereas a selection committee was struck compromised of the seven lower tier Municipal Clerks to review applications for the Joint Municipal Election Audit Committee 2022.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Cramahé hereby enacts as follows:

1. **That** the Joint Municipal Election Audit Committee shall consist of the following five (5) individuals to deal with each compliance audit request in accordance with the Terms of Reference as set out in Schedule "A" to By-law 2022-30:
 - James Hunt
 - Jim Harris
 - Tom Tordoff
 - Bill Graham
 - Michael Waddell
2. **That** the Joint Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee shall carry out its mandate and duties in accordance with the Township of Cramahé Procedural By-law and the Terms of Reference of the Election Compliance Audit.
3. **That** this by-law shall be deemed to be in force and effect as of July 19, 2022.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 19 day of July 2022.
