1. That I am the app	licant for the grant of a	permit authorizing me to	keep backyard

- hens pursuant to By-Law 16-22 within the Township of Cramahe now and hereafter in force. I undertake to conform to the terms, conditions and regulations set out in By-law 16-22 and zoning By-law 08-18 including:
  - a. No hen coop shall not exceed three (3) meters by three (3) meters in size, and 3.5 meters in height
  - b. Hen coop shall be located at least three (3) meters from the side lot line, and at least 3 meters from the rear lot line of the lot on which the hen coop is located;
  - c. Hen coop shall be located at least ten (10) meters from:
    - i. Residences, uses or facilities where people sleep, for example, dwellings, nursing homes, hospitals, trailer parks, camp grounds, mobile home parks, etc.; and
    - ii. Permanent institutional uses such as schools, churches, municipal offices, libraries, community centres and day care centres
  - d. Hen coop shall be located at least fifteen (15) meters from a well with a watertight casing to a depth of at least six (6) meters, or at least thirty (30) meters from a spring used as a source or potable water or well other than a well with a watertight casing to a depth of at least six (6) meters.
  - e. Hen coop shall be located in the rear yard only



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- f. No person shall keep more than six (6) Hens on any land not zoned for agricultural use
- g. Hen coops must be kept in a clean and sanitary condition at all times, free of vermin, obnoxious smells and substances
- h. Hens must have access to feed and clean water at all times, and kept in a clean, healthy environment
- i. Hens must be kept securely in the coop at all times, they may not run at large
- j. Any stored Hen manure must be kept in a fully enclosed structure that does not exceed three (3) cubic feet
- k. Deceased Hens must be promptly disposed of in a sanitary manner in accordance with all applicable laws
- I. Licencee must reside on the same property as the Hen or Hens for which the licence is issued
- m. Licencee shall allow, at any reasonable time, a By-Law Officer, along with any other authorized employee or agent of the Township, to enter upon the Property to determine whether the requirements of By-Law 2016-22 are being complied with
- n. If, at any time, the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer determines, as a result of evidence that is provided, that the operation of hen coop or the activities of an owner do not conform with the requirements of this by-law, it may suspend or revoke the licence
- o. A change in occupancy or ownership shall make the hen coop licence null and void
- 2. I understand and agree that I must comply with all applicable regulations and requirements of:
  - a. Applicable by-laws of the Township of Cramahe
  - b. Applicable Provincial and Federal Act and regulation made under such act;
