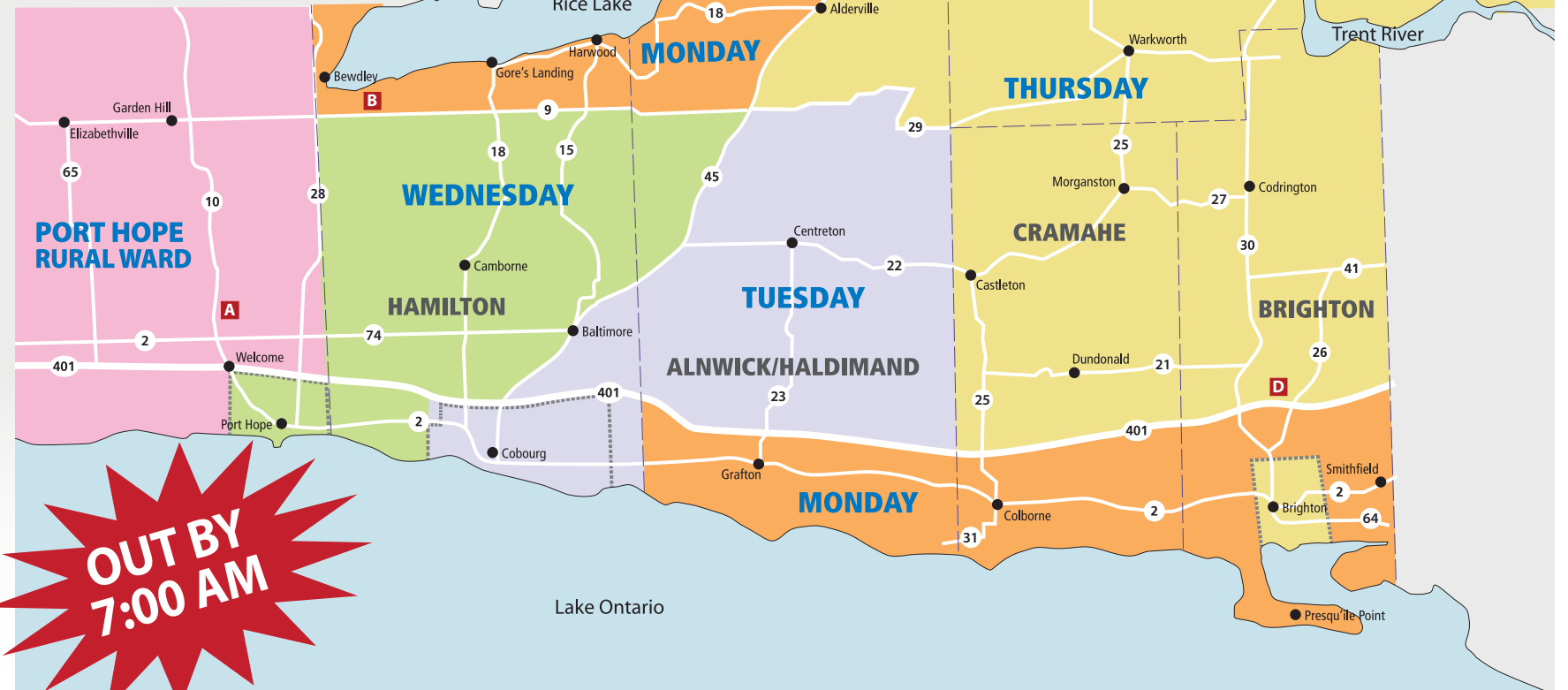

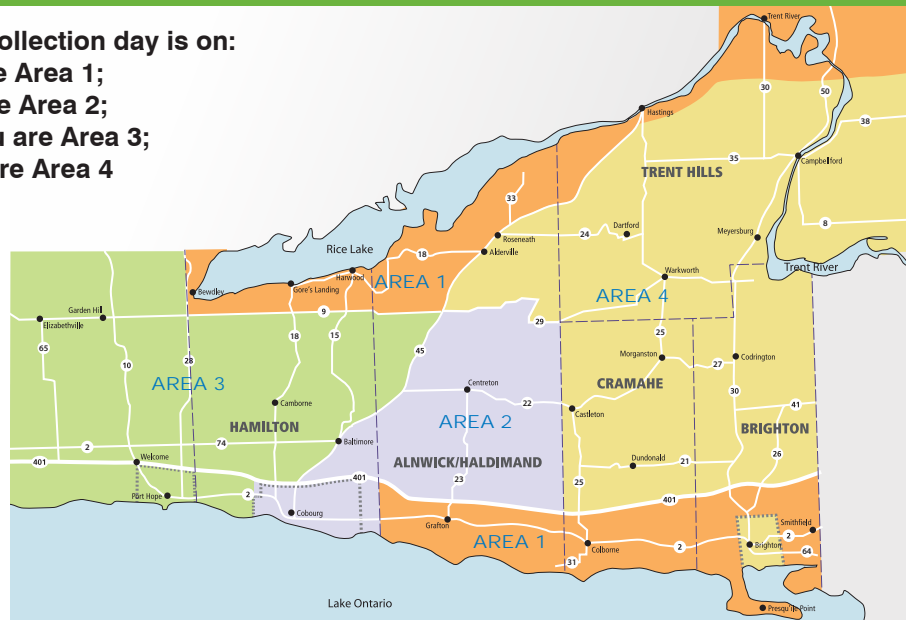

Northumberland County provides monthly pick up of leaf & yard waste at your curb on a routine schedule, from April to Mid-December. Refer to April to December calendar months for the schedule of collection days for each area.

Have brush, leaves and grass clippings at the curb by 7 a.m. on the Monday of your designated set-out week, not on your garbage/recycling collection day. It will be collected between Monday and Friday of your designated set-out week. See below for details.

Rules & Tips



Tie brush into bundles no longer than 1m (3 feet), and with no material larger than 5cm (2") diameter.



Each bag/bundle must weigh less than 20 kgs (44 pounds).



Roll tops of bags shut. This sheds the rain and snow and prevents leaves from falling or blowing out.



Leaves **MUST** be in paper yard waste bags.



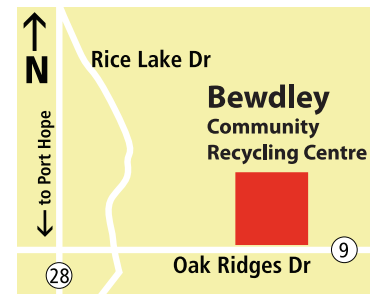
Only use paper yard waste bags.



No garbage, litter, animal feces, stumps or soil.

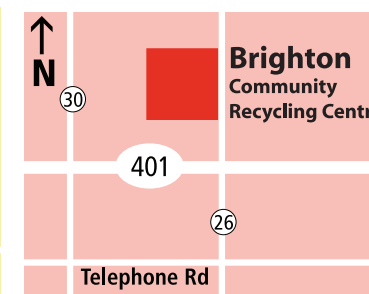

We do not collect Christmas Trees, however...

They can be taken to any CRC during operating hours to be disposed of as leaf and yard waste. Or, call your local Municipality for inquiries about Christmas tree collection in your area.

Remove tinsel, decorations and plastic before disposal.



Flatten Corrugated Cardboard Boxes

Corrugated cardboard boxes must be flattened and bundled in dimensions no larger than 30" x 30" x 10" with tape or twine. This ensures that bundles will not only fit in the collection truck, but in our baler at the Material Recovery Facility in Grafton.

Stuff all soft plastic bags into one bag, tie, then put on top of your blue box.

Acceptable 

- Plastic grocery/retail bags
- Toilet paper/napkin/paper towel overwrap
- Bottled water/pop case overwrap
- Milk/bread outer bags (no inner milk pouches)
- Garden product bags (e.g., soil, mulch, etc.)
- Plastic water softener/salt bags
- Newspaper/flyer bags
- Sandwich bags (Ziploc® bags)
- Shipping air pillows and envelopes
- Plastic bubble wrap
- Other plastic bags identified by a #2 or #4 recycling symbol

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation takes place each year on September 30. This day honours the lost children and survivors of Canada's Indian Residential School System, along with their families and communities.

This day builds on the Orange Shirt Day movement, which grew out of the story of one survivor, Phyllis Webstad, who had her new orange shirt taken away on her first day at a residential school.

Recognizing these occasions **with meaningful discussion and activity** is an important part of Canada's ongoing process of reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples.

Medical Waste is not recyclable
IV tubes, bags, face masks, gloves, bandages, etc., are not recyclable. Put medical waste in the garbage. Return sharps including syringes to your local pharmacy.



Rinsing Matters
Rinse out food waste from plastic and metal containers before recycling. If food waste is left in jars, cans, and bottles there is a good chance those items will not be recycled.

Blue/Grey Box tips

Below are some tips to keep in mind.

Blue Box

- Rinse your recyclables. Dirty plastic or glass containers do not get recycled.
- Remove metal lids on glass jars and put separately in the blue box.
- Do not crush cans or bottles.
- Keep material loose. Do not bag materials aside from plastic bags and shredded paper



Grey Box

- Flatten paperboard boxes (cracker, cereal, etc.). This saves a lot of space in the grey box!
- Remove plastic sleeve from newspapers. Newspapers go in the grey box, the sleeve goes in your bags or bags.
- Fold paper gift wrap to save space.
- No metallic gift wrap will be accepted.

The week of December 25th is a double bump week. Collection will occur two days past your regular collection day as Christmas Day and Boxing Day both land during the week.

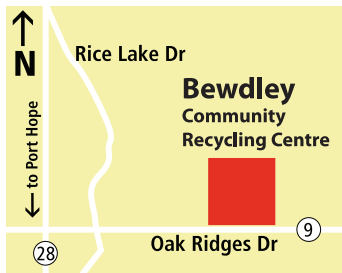

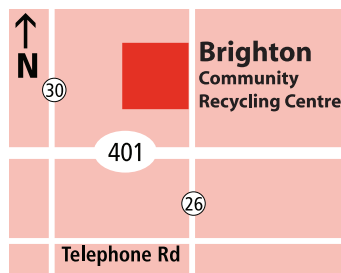

HHW Trip Tips

1. Bring needles in a sealed container (i.e. 2 litre pop bottle). **We will not handle loose needles.**
2. If it took a friend to load it, bring a friend to unload it. Staff do not unload vehicles.
3. Bring liquid or powder waste in a sealed, labelled container.
4. We do not empty gasoline, oil, or antifreeze. The container you bring it in will not be returned to you. Oil, gasoline and antifreeze need to be in pails **less than 20L (5 gallons)**. We do not accept drums.
5. Hazardous Waste is only accepted from Northumberland County residents.

Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

Drop off E-Waste* for no charge at any CRC year-round, every day they are open.

Curbside Reminders For Household Garbage

Please Remember:

1. Have your waste to the curb by 7AM on your collection day;
2. Each household is allowed to set out up to **two (2)** standard size opaque garbage bags each week;
3. Place a green bag tag around the neck of each bag, sticking it end to end like a clothespin;
4. Full bag tag must be visible for collection;
5. Each bag can weigh no more than 20 kilograms (44 pounds);
6. Bags placed in garbage cans must be tagged on the bag, not on the can. Size of garbage cans/bins no larger than 80 litres (17 gallons);
7. Half-tags may be used on grocery style bags with handles, weighing no more than 9 kilograms (20 pounds). A full tag, cut lengthwise must be placed on the side of the bag or around the neck. **DO NOT** place this bag in your blue or grey box;
8. Label garbage cans 'GARBAGE' to help collectors clearly identify the cans containing garbage from cans containing recyclable material;
9. Place sharp objects (like broken glass) into a box labeled as such, and place beside your garbage bag at the curb for pickup;

Curbside Reminders For Recycling

Please Remember:

1. Have your recycling to the curb by 7AM on your collection day;
2. Cardboard boxes must be flattened and bundled using tape or twine in 76 cm x 76 cm x 25 cm (30" x 30" x 10") dimensions;
3. An unlimited number of properly sorted residential grey and blue boxes can be set out for collection each week;
4. Soft plastic bags **MUST** be bagged in one bag, tied at the top and put into your blue box;
5. Rinse recyclables that contained food or drink;
6. Broken blue and grey boxes can be exchanged for no charge at any Community Recycling Centre;
7. To avoid and reduce wind blown litter, **DO NOT** overfill your bins. Additional bins are available for \$6 ea (subject to change), and can be purchased at any Community Recycling Centre;

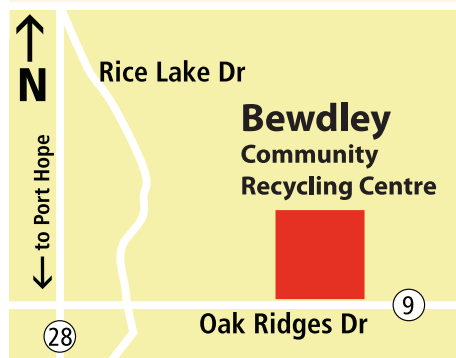

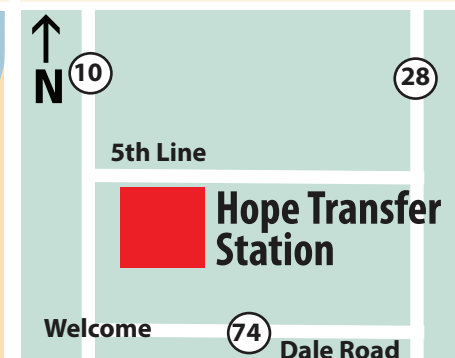
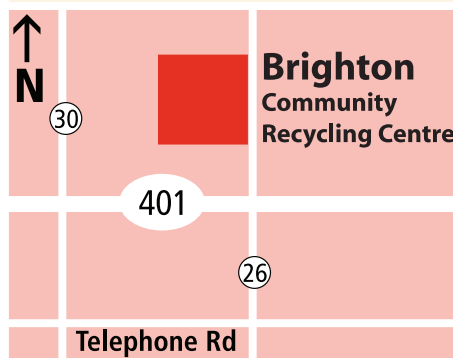
