# Big Apple, request for Council Endorsement, dated February 17, 2017 Resolution #17-82

WHEREAS multiple attractions in one local area contribute to the success of all attractions in that same local area; and

**WHEREAS** the success of the Big Apple, a local attraction situated in Cramahe Township, Ontario, will be enhanced by the development of an additional tourist attraction in the area, one that will increase the likelihood that travelers passing through the township will stop and visit the area; and
