### **Kennel Regulations:**

#### Class I Kennel:

- More than three (3) dogs but no more than eight (8) dogs residing on the same property at the same time, including for commercial or home industry purposes.
- No portion of the kennel, including the run area, will be closer than 50 meters (164 feet) of a neighboring residence, dwelling unit, or residential zone.
- The kennel, including run area, must not be located closer to the street line than the principal or main building on the lot, and shall further be erected in conformity with the yard and setback requirements of the respective zone.

#### Class II Kennel:

- More than eight (8) dogs residing on the same property at the same time, including for commercial or home industry purposes.
- No portion of the kennel, including the run area, will be closer than 200 meters (656 feet) of a neighboring residence, dwelling unit, or residential zone.
- The kennel, including run area, must not be located closer to the street line than the principal or main building on the lot, and shall further be erected in conformity with the yard and setback requirements of the respective zone.
- 1. A 'Kennel Permit' is required for any property that houses more than three (3) dogs at one time.
- 2. The Kennel shall mean the building and adjoining property to which the dogs have access and for which a kennel permit has been obtained. The 'Kennel' comprises all areas of the property (including buildings and run areas) to which the dogs have access.
- 3. A current year dog tag will be issued at no charge and attached to each dog in the kennel..
- 4. Prior to issuing a license, the By-law Enforcement officer will review all new Kennel Applications (Appendix "C") submitted. The By-law Enforcement officer shall ensure that the proposed kennel is compatible with the existing land uses of the subject and neighboring properties. As such, additional conditions may be required to be satisfied prior to a kennel license being issued.
- 5. New Kennel Permit Applications will require a site visit.
- 6. Kennels existing before 1 January 2009 are grandfathered.
