

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRAMAHE

BY-LAW NO. BL-2022-18

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A LARGE ANIMAL POUND KEEPER AND LIVESTOCK VALUER AND TO SET THE REMUNERATION FOR THOSE POSITIONS.

WHEREAS the Wildlife Damage Compensation Program and the Protection of Livestock and Poultry and Honey Bee Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, states that the Council of every municipality shall appoint one or more persons as valuers of livestock and poultry for the purposes of those Acts; and

WHEREAS it is the intention of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cramahe to carry out the provisions of the Pounds Act, R.S.O. 1990, and to appoint an individual to do so; and


WHEREAS a municipality may appoint employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the corporation or for carrying into effect any Act of the Legislature or by-law and for fixing their remuneration and prescribing their duties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Cramahe hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Rodger Dingman (the "appointee") be appointed as the Livestock Valuer for the Township of Cramahe and shall be responsible for administering the provisions of the Wildlife Damage Compensation Program and the Protection of Livestock and Poultry and Honey Bee Act; and
2. **THAT** remuneration for the appointee is set as eighty dollars (\$80.00) per call, and mileage per kilometer as set by Council for travel expense; and
3. **THAT** Ed Van Egmond be appointed as the Large Animal Pound keeper for the Township of Cramahe, and shall be responsible for administering the provisions of the Pounds Act; and
4. **THAT** said appointee agrees to supply all items and equipment necessary to carry out these duties, and that he has sufficient yards and enclosures for the safekeeping of large animals; and
5. **THAT** remuneration for the appointee is set at fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) per hour, and mileage per kilometer as set by Council for travel expense; and
6. **THAT** a fee of not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) per day, per animal, plus mileage per kilometer as set by Council for traveling expense shall be paid to the appointee by the owner of an animal found to be at large and impounded by the appointee; and

7. **THAT** By-law 2011-51, and any other by-law relating to the appointment of livestock valuers and large animal pound keepers and hereby repealed; and
8. **That** this by-law shall be deemed to be in force and effect as of March 15, 2022.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 15 day of March 2022.
