

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRAMAHE

BY-LAW NO. BL-2026-28

Being a By-law to designate certain highways as "Community Safety Zone" throughout the Township of Cramahe.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 214.1(1) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter H.8 as amended, the Council of a municipality may by by-law designate a part of a highway under its jurisdiction as a community safety zone, if, in the Council's opinion, public safety is of special concern over that part of the highway; and


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cramahe deems it advisable to designate certain highways, listed as Schedule A to this by-law, as community safety zone;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Cramahe hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the following roadways listed on Schedule A are designated as community safety zones; and
2. **THAT** the "Community Safety Zone" is in effect twenty-four (24) hours each day, Monday through Sunday, year round; and
3. **THAT** the signs noting "Community Safety Zone" shall be erected in accordance with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act; and
4. **THAT** By-law 2014-41 is hereby repealed; and
5. **THAT** this by-law shall be deemed to be in force and effect as of the date of its passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23rd day of June, 2026.
